



RoHS Policy

Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment

We hereby advise that wherever possible, to our knowledge and after careful checking with our suppliers, materials supplied to Bluemay Weston Limited (“the Company”) are compliant with the current RoHS Directive 3 (EU 2015/863) and as such do not contain or exceed allowable levels of restricted substances as specified in the RoHS Directive 3.

The only exception is that any products made with clear PVC are not RoHS compliant and should not be purchased for inclusion in electrical and electronic equipment. If this is an issue the use of alternative RoHS-compliant materials should be discussed at enquiry stage.

We require suppliers to the Company to review and keep up to date with RoHS regulations and to notify the Company of any changes with regard to the compliance of substances supplied. The Company will in turn notify customers of any relevant changes.

Since the presence of the substances mentioned above cannot be expected under normal circumstances, the Company does not check for their absence.
